New Worlds Reading Initiative

The Florida Legislature created the New Worlds Reading Initiative (NWRI), it provides eligible elementary students an incredible opportunity to build personalized, at-home libraries that reflect their unique interests and backgrounds at no cost to families or schools. The state has contracted with the UF Lastinger Center for Learning, administered by NWRI in partnership with Scholastic, to select and deliver nine books (one per month) to the home address of eligible students who enroll in the program. Any student in grades K-5 identified as having a substantial deficiency in reading can participate.

Mrs. Rios our Parent Engagement Liason (PEL) is reaching out to parents of students who are eligible to participate.
