

Upcoming Curriculum

In kindergarten, we are finishing up the school year by reviewing skills in reading and math. We will be reading stories like Panda Kindergarten and working with Nearpods.

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In Science will be learn more about plants and animals and in Social Studies we will learn about jobs and money. What a great year it has been! Have a wonderful summer!

Happy May! This school year has flown by! In May first grade will be learning: Math: We will learn all about clocks and how to tell time to the hour and half hour. We will also spend time reviewing all of our first grade skills and getting ready for second grade! Science: Review of Living/Nonliving, we will spend time researching and writing about animals and their habitats. Reading: Our last reading unit is Reading Across Genres. We will be reading informational texts while working to identify the topic and relevant details of a text, use text features to help understand the text, explain similarities and differences between information provided in visuals and words, identify and explain descriptive words and phrases, retell a text and compare and contrast two texts on the same topic. Phonics: oy, oi, au, aw, ghost letters

To begin the month of May – second-grade will continue our focus on the reading of informational text. We will be diving deeper into text features, central idea, author's purpose, and comparing and contrasting important details in two texts on the same topic or theme. In math, we will begin what is called the B.E.S.T Benchmark Blitz. This is a review and enrichment of all the math standards we have covered this year. In science, we will be working on a number of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) activities. In social studies, we continue to work on a unit focused on economics. We will be learning to recognize that people make choices because of limited resources, that people supply goods and services based on consumer demands, and that the United States trades with other nations to exchange goods and services.

May Issue

We are in the final stretch of the 2022-2023 school year! Third grade takes their final FAST tests on May 2nd and May 3rd. We will be doing our end of year iReady the following week, both reading and math. After testing, we will be reading and writing about unique animal adaptations as well as doing our Matilda novel study. In math, we will have completed all of the third grade standards! We will work on reviewing specific third grade math topics as well as previewing upcoming fourth grade math standards.

4th Grade has learned so much this year and we are ready to show what we know! We will spend the first week in May testing. After we complete our testing, we will be getting ready for 5th grade. In ELA and Math, we will be previewing 5th grade standards with Step-Up lessons. We will also be completing two cross-curricular activities. We will research a florida animal for science and create a presentation in ELA. We will also complete a pirate project in social studies and complete a pirate themed escape room in math. We hope to have a fun-filled learning experience in the month of May!

The Month we have all been waiting for!


